





# Mood Williams Camp Scholarship Fund



Established in 2023, this fund was created in memory of our beloved friend, Mood Williams, who was a long-time supporter, one of our biggest cheerleaders, and part of our Go Jen Go family. After our co-founder, Jen Pagani's passing, Mood always focused on how her sons were doing. He knew it was a formative time in their lives and the impact their mom fighting and passing away from breast cancer had on their childhood and future.

## The Need

- **5 million** children — **1 in every 15** — are coping with a parent's cancer diagnosis in the U.S.
- Research shows a **cancer diagnosis has a significant impact on a household**, underscoring the need for support to help children cope with any drastic changes.
- **Socialization and play are crucial** for young people's normal brain and body development. Having dedicated time for fun helps them feel "normal" and not different from their peers. (*American Association of Caregiving Youth*)
